Central Lonsdale's commercial main street between 14th and 18th streets offer a vibrant communal space for people to visit neighbouring businesses, connect with a friend or sit and enjoy the neighbourhood.

Originally a response to the COVID-19 pandemic to permit outdoor gathering spaces and patio space for businesses, the Open Streets program has brought street seats, urban gardens and community programming to enhance street vibrancy and sociability in the area, and support a healthy and connected neighbourhood and main street.
