The New Harry Jerome Community Recreation Centre Project and Silver Harbour Seniors' Activity Centre (HJCRC/SH) will deliver more than 18,580 sq.m. of inclusive and accessible community space when completed. This month, the next major milestone will be underway with the delivery and installation of structural steel. Once the structural steel installation begins, the building form will really start to take shape! Construction on concrete works, backfill, construction mock-ups, and mechanical and electrical rough-in work continues.
