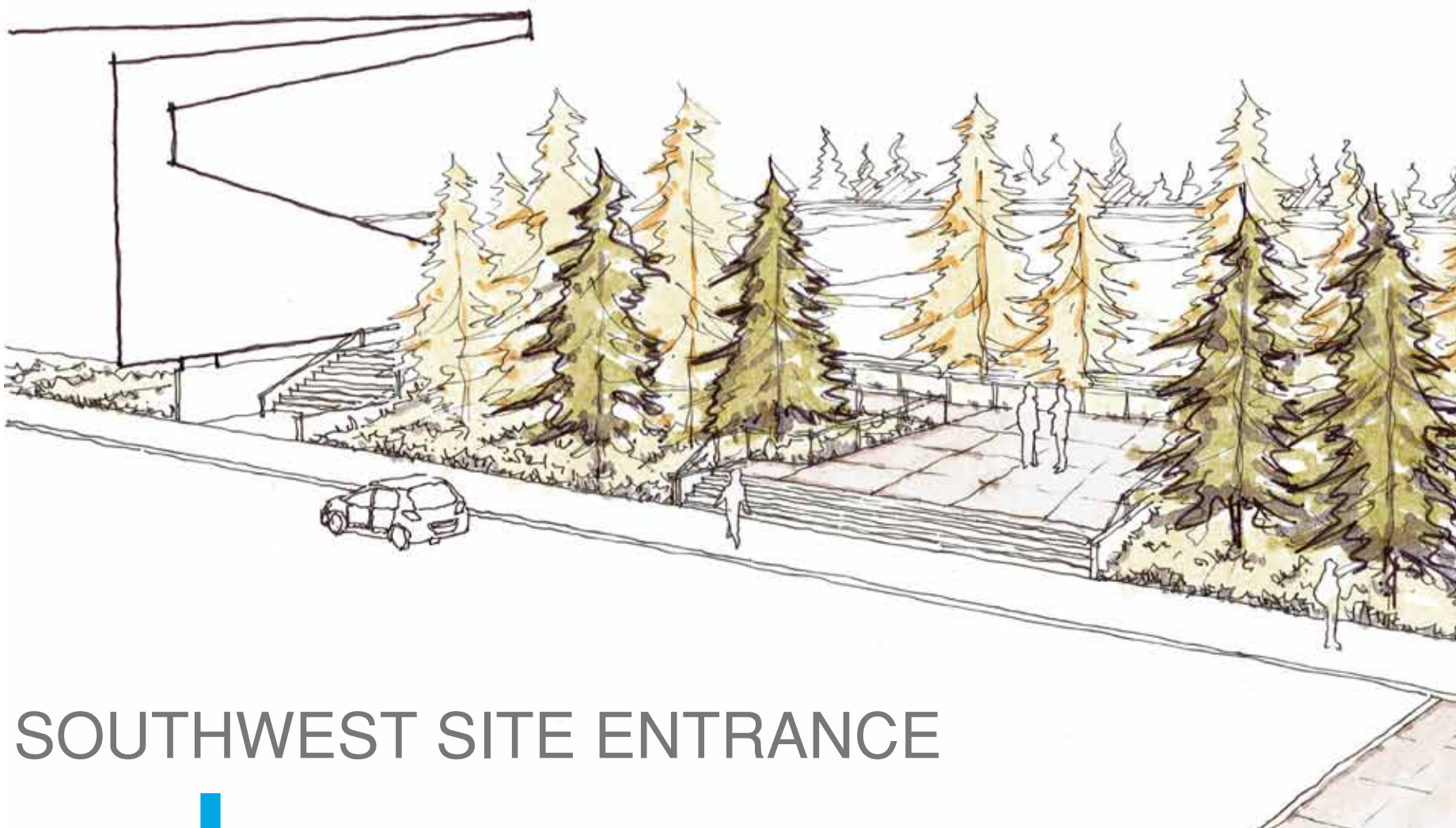

CONCEPTUAL LAYOUT

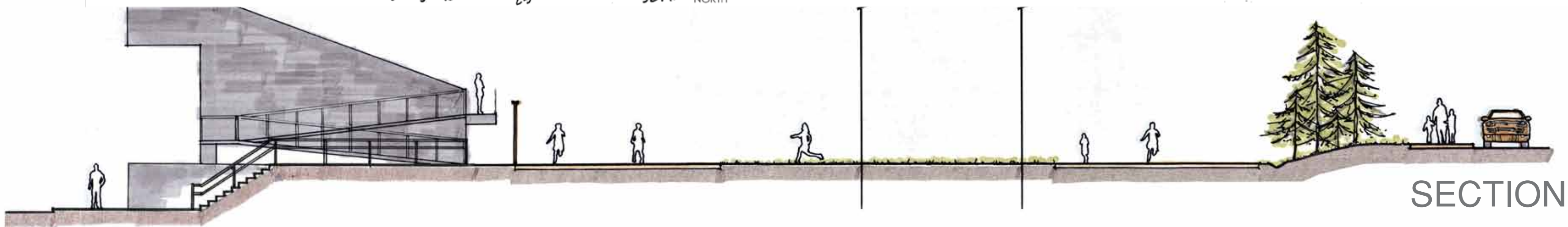
KEY DESIGN COMPONENTS

- Field would require upgrade to existing parking lot on west side of field.
- Existing lighting will be upgraded.
- Existing community track will be retained
- Player warm-up available in track area
- Existing washrooms, change rooms, and stadium to be utilized

KEY DESIGN COMPONENTS

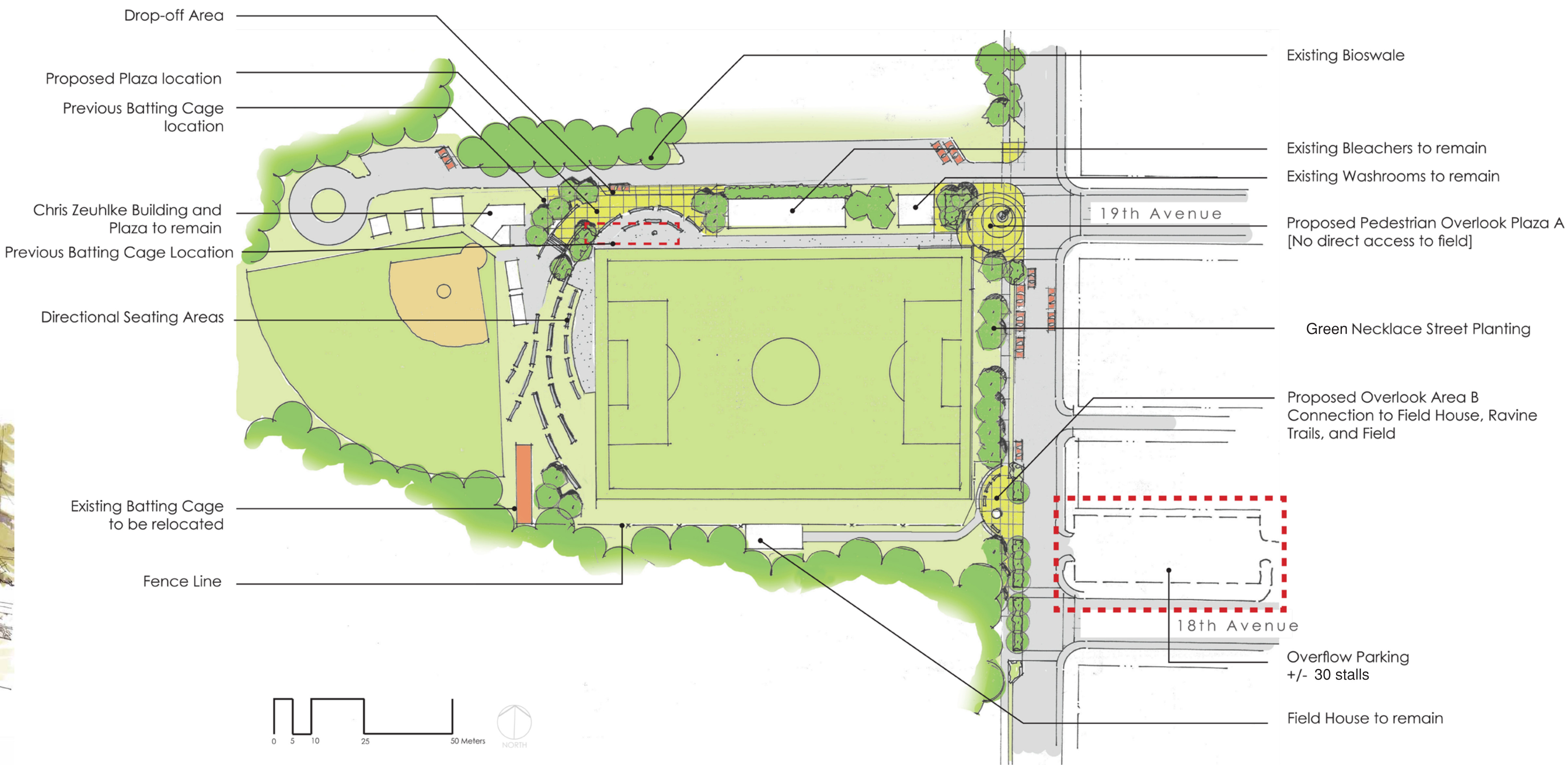
- Field would require sportsfield lighting

- Off-street parking adjacent to field prone to conflict with Kinsmen North softball (foul balls etc.)



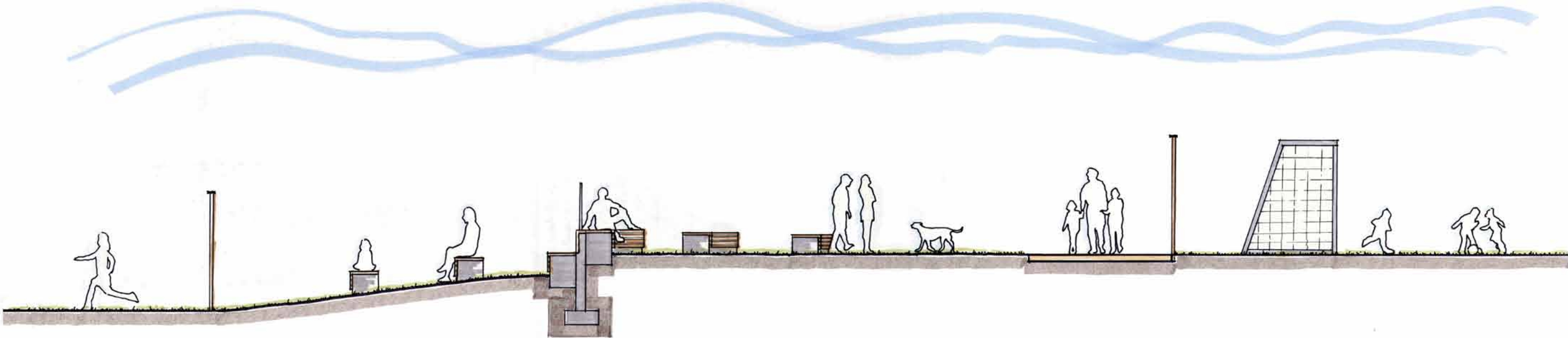

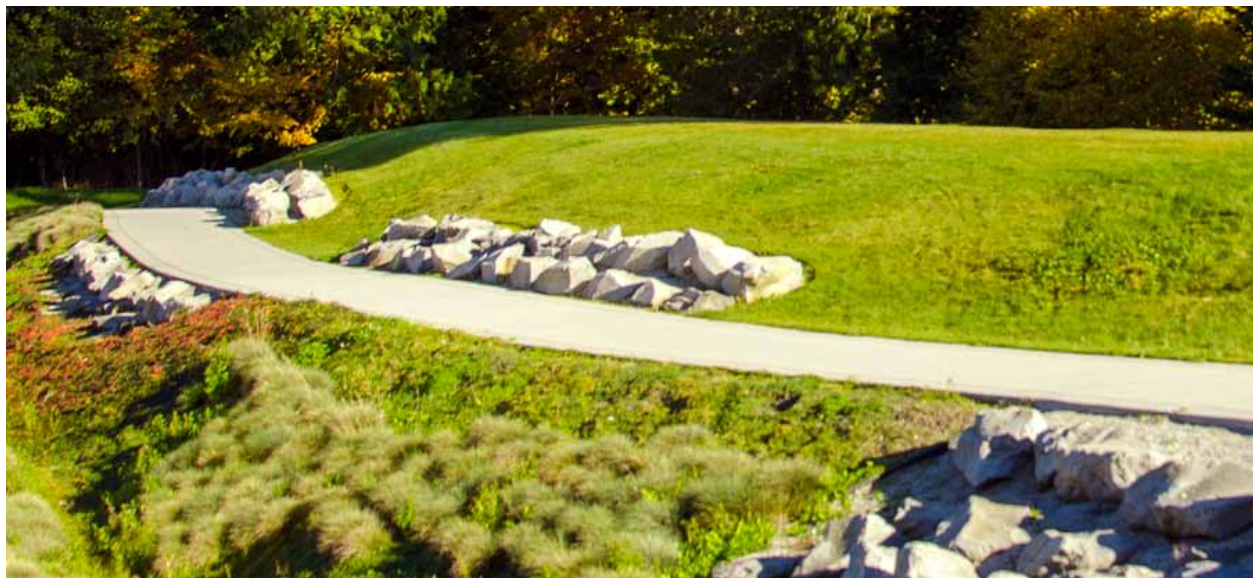
