Councillor Bob Fearnley was first elected as City Councillor in 1996 and is serving his fifth term on Council. He has a long standing interest in energy policy, urban planning, sustainability, and substance abuse policy.

Councillor Fearnley is a past President of the Lower Mainland Local Government Association. He also served as the Chair of the Lower Mainland Substance Abuse Strategy Committee, and was the Lower Mainland representative for the Union of BC Municipalities. Councillor Fearnley chaired a regional committee of municipal officials concerned with energy policy, and was a driving force behind the establishment of the City's new district heating system.

Laura works with the City of North Vancouver, City of Vancouver and Light House, providing education and outreach services. She is currently engaging residents in climate action through LiveSmart BC, a provincial incentive program that offers homeowners up to \$13,675 in rebates for home energy upgrades. Previously, she worked with Light House developing and delivering the Green Building 101 course. She holds a Masters degree in Environmental Education and Communication from Royal Roads University, and is vice-chair of the Parks and Environment Advisory Committee for the City of North Vancouver. Laura lives in North Vancouver.

Doug joined Light House Sustainable Building Centre in May 2008 after completing his Diploma in Building Technology from BCIT where he specialized in Building Science. Prior to BCIT Doug spent over 20 years as an IT professional performing a number of roles from network design and computer management to coordinating and managing IT projects. Doug brings along 'Green' knowledge gained from activities and projects outside of his working career. His passion for the environment and sustainability is evident through his bicycle oriented transportation, the generation of all his electrical needs from his roof-top solar panel system and his lifestyle organization to minimize his environmental footprint.
