Councillor Guy Heywood, B.A., MBA (UBC) has worked for three major banks where he was a currency trader, a commercial lender and project finance specialist. He has also worked in senior positions at two large BC-based public companies. In the community, Guy was elected 3 times as Trustee and Chair of the North Vancouver School District and more recently has served as Chair of the North Vancouver Recreation Commission. He currently serves on the Board of Governors for the Certified General Accountants of BC. This is his first term on North Vancouver City Council.

This year he and his two partners at mgb have been nominated for the Marcus Prize in Architecture.

Michael believes that the integrity of the architectural profession is to build with modesty, simplicity and maturity. He is strongly committed to buildings that are responsible to the Earth.
