


Disc Golf and Park Improvements

Proposed "6 Hole" Disc Golf Layout


- Revegetate area near removed holes native shrubs + trees
- Proposed new trail alignment



Proposed Improvements to Eastview Park

Below are options that could be implemented in Eastview Park:

- 1. Remove disc golf baskets #1, #2 and #9.
- 2. Relocate bench near the "new" disc golf Tee #1 and away from Cedar Village Close.
- 3. Revegetate area around the disc golf baskets #1, #2 and #9 with native shrubs and trees.
- **4.** Add a concrete pad for the "seasonal toilet" and add a wooden surround to contain the structure and improve aesthetics.
- **5.** Establish a trail for a direct route to Rufus Drive. Decommission a section of the trail located near the current #9 basket.
- **6.** Revise disc golf signs to establish "hours of use" (suggested 9am to 8pm).
- Add regulatory signage to reinforce that Eastview Park is a dog on leash park.
