Mahon Park Improvements



Mahon Park is one of the City's largest and oldest parks and has a well-established history in both sports and its natural setting. Following completion of recent renovations to Fen Burdett Stadium field, focus has shifted to renovating and revitalizing the west corner of the park, site of the former horseshoe club facility.

The aging building and horseshoe pitches are scheduled for removal and the City is asking the community to help guide future improvements and provide feedback on design ideas for proposed updates to the layout and new amenities to better integrate and utilize this area of the park.

Community feedback will be documented to develop future design concept(s).

Park Background


Mahon Park Site History

Mahon Park outdoor swimming pool opened in July 1949 and was a popular place for summer time family recreation for several decades. After its closure, due to possible structural issues from years of heavy water loading at the top of the bank, the pool tank was filled, leveled and paved to provide a new venue for horse pitching and the home of the local Horseshoe Club. The facility was well used for many years until interest in the sport dropped and the club dissolved by early 2000. A basketball court was added just below the former pool/horseshoe pitch to encourage informal use but for the most part, the area has remained unused since the club shut down.



Design Idea

Former Horseshoe / Pool Area may include:

- Golf hole plus a putting and chipping area.

Surrounding Area may include:

- Resurfacing the existing basketball court.
- A new multi-use court area to possibly accommodate bocce, yoga, exercise, training or associated programming with the Margaret Fulton Adult Day Care Centre.
- Picnic tables may be added to the open grass area to facilitate picnicking and other social events and gatherings.
- A picnicking area is envisioned at the north to complement the water park and play areas.
- Groupings of shade trees and landscaped areas are proposed for accent, shade and buffer between activity areas.



- Picnicking is envisioned for the open lawn area near the water play.
- Additional shade trees and landscaped areas are proposed for accent, shade and buffer between activity areas.
- Existing basketball court to be resurfaced.

Design Idea


Former Horseshoe / Pool Area may include:

- A multi-sport area which may include a combination of pickleball, sand volleyball, putting and chipping green.


Surrounding Area may include:

- Additional shade trees and landscaped areas are added for accent, shade and buffer.



Idea 1- (4) Pickleball Courts




Idea 2- (3) Sand Volleyball Courts
