Prior to requesting inspection:

- Obtain documentation must be submitted <u>at time of inspection request</u>
- □ Changes from issued permits and drawings revisions submitted and approved for building, trades, HVAC
- □ Trade Inspections under slab complete

Documentation – must be submitted at time of inspection request:

- □ Registered Professional field review fill under slab if applicable
- □ Registered Professional field review insulation/moisture barrier if applicable
- Registered Professional field review and manufacturers specifications with installation instructions for Soil Gas Depressurization, if using system other than BC Building Code and CAN/CGSB-149.11
- □ Email inspection request with documentation: <u>permitinspections@cnv.org</u>

Typical items reviewed on site:

- □ Building Permit Card posted
- □ Construction activity hour / contact signage posted
- □ Roads / sidewalks clean / siltation control in place
- □ Site safety
- □ Registered Professional field review excavation site safety **posted at site**
- □ Issued Building Permit plans on site
- □ Temporary stairs, guards and handrails to access building and floor levels
- □ Temporary guards interior and exterior fall protection
- □ Moisture / air / vapour barrier sealed at foundation / footing / pipe / penetrations
- □ Radon system sealed / labels BCBC / CAN/CGSB-149.11 level 2 provisions
- □ Insulation
- □ Proposed slab elevations interior / exterior / patio and stair wells / garage
- □ Minimum 18" frost protection maintained
- □ Conformity to approved building permit plans

This is a list of items with a high failure rate and is provided as a guide to successful results.

To avoid failed inspections, inspections not conducted and re-inspection fees, ensure work is complete, meets minimum BC Building Code / CNV Bylaws and WorkSafeBC. Approved permit plans must be on site for inspections.
