Notification to all vendors

Under the Safety Standards Act, a certification mark is required for all portable vending carts, mobile food service equipment, mobile showers, and mobile washrooms for both gas and electrical.

BCSA can be contacted directly by individual vendors for clarification.

Electrical

For electrical certification, an approved certification marking is required. If an approved certification marking is not present, a BCSA Silver Label inspection permit can be obtained and completed by a licensed electrical contractor.

Once an inspection is completed, a Silver Label will be affixed by the electrical safety officer on final inspection. Below is an example of a BCSA Silver Label:

<u>Gas</u>

For gas certification, a BCSA Gas Certification Label is required.

All mobile food service equipment, mobile showers, mobile washrooms will require a qualified gas contractor to obtain the appropriate installation permit and notify BCSA for final inspection. Once completed, a Certification Label will be affixed by the gas safety officer. Below is an example of a BCSA Gas Certification Label:
