Columbaria Niche Door Memorial Engraving Standards
Block 210 & Block 211 with Lots 1-80 in each unit

These columbaria are located at the top of Lillooet Lane and are oriented with east and west facing niches. They each have five rows with 40 niches per side. Each niche holds a maximum of two urns. The niche doors are 12" x 12" carnelian mahogany granite. The columbaria units are made of sierra white granite.

All columbaria memorial inscriptions must be approved by the City with engraving carried out by one of the following companies.

The family may choose the font, date format, graphic and sentiment but must adhere to the City's engraving standards.

- No inscribed or painted borders
- No colored paint except white paint
- Sunken lettering only
- No sunken background
- No flashed background
- No laser engraving
- Small graphic (maximum 8" wide by 3 ½" tall) is permitted at the top end of the door
- There must be a minimum of ½" of free space left around the edges of the niche door
- No vases of any kind or anything attached to the door
- Name of the deceased in English in addition to any other language

Urn Specifications

Cremated remains must be enclosed in a sealed container or urn constructed of permanent, durable material. The right holder is responsible for ensuring that the urns used for interment in the columbaria will fit within the niche. The interior niche dimensions are 12"W x 12"H x 15"D.
