Cemetery

The North Vancouver Cemetery has served residents of the North Shore since 1907. Nestled below the majestic North Shore mountains, the Cemetery is a special place of remembrance, history and beauty. It is a treasured space where people take time to reflect and reconnect with nature.

The North Vancouver Cemetery is approximately 22 acres (nine hectares) in size and lies on a 62-acre (25-hectare) parcel of land located at 1700 Lillooet Road.
