

BURRARD DRY DOCK PIER

The **Burrard Dry Dock Pier** is a signature landmark and the City of North Vancouver's largest pier. It is best suited to large naval vessels, small cruise ships and other oversize recreational vessels.

Located at The Shipyards at the foot of Lonsdale, the area offers a mixed use of shops, restaurants and hotels with spectacular 360-degree views of the North Shore and Vancouver skylines.

The Shipyards hosts several special events throughout the year, and any vessel docked at The Pier can join in the festivities.

HIGHLIGHTS AND FEATURES

- 700ft long, 50ft wide public promenade
- Suitable moorage for vessels up to 440ft long with a 4,470 tonne displacement
- Timber rub rails and long, rubber cylinder fenders for mooring
- Pier vehicle load capacity of 15,000kg (5,400kg front axle and 9,500kg rear axle)
- Potable water available

The Burrard Dry Dock Pier is located 650ft. east of the Lower Lonsdale Bus Exchange and SeaBus Terminal to downtown Vancouver. It is close to public parking and has easy street access.

MOORAGE AT THE SHIPYARDS

ST. ROCH DOCK

The 100ft. long **St. Roch Dock** It is located next to Burrard Dry Dock Pier and can accommodate smaller vessels such as pleasure craft, harbour tours or water taxis.

HIGHLIGHTS AND FEATURES

- Moorage of vessels up to 80ft long with a 66 tonne displacement
- Timber bull rail and rub rails, four cleats per side
- Free moorage is permitted without a permit to a maximum of three hours, on a first-come first-serve basis
- A Moorage Agreement is required for moorage longer than three hours
- Ideal for visiting local restaurants and other attractions
