Eligibility and Requirements

The City of North Vancouver is committed to engaging with the community to learn about the important issues and challenges faced by the residents. The City's Advisory Committees offer valuable volunteer opportunities to help shape policies and practices that are relevant to City of North Vancouver residents, while providing Council with valuable insights about their unique lived experiences and advice on how to best approach challenges and opportunities.

All community members who meet the required qualifications are welcome to apply. We are seeking a broad cross-section of applicants that reflect diverse perspectives and enhance our community as "A City for People" that is welcoming, inclusive, safe, accessible and supports the health and well-being of all.

Application Criteria

- Applicants must be residents of the City of North Vancouver*.
- Applicants must not be employees of the City of North Vancouver.
- Applicants should be available to attend the Advisory Committee meetings and able to serve for the full term of the appointment.

*Some exceptions may apply based on the specific Terms of Reference for each Advisory Committee. Please contact Legislative Services for more information.

Time Commitment

The time requirements vary between the Advisory Committees. Most of the Advisory Committees meet in the evening, once a month for 2-3 hours. Generally, there are no meetings in August or December.

Remuneration

As these are volunteer positions, Advisory Committee members serve without remuneration.

You may only be appointed to one Advisory Committee at a time, except for rare exceptions granted by Council. All applicants will receive a letter from Legislative Services once the appointments have been made.
