The meeting was called to order at 6:02 pm.

1. ADOPTION OF AGENDA

The agenda was approved as circulated.

2. ADOPTION OF MINUTES

Minutes of the meeting held on March 5, 2025 were approved as circulated.

3. BUSINESS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES

4. OFFICIAL COMMUNITY PLAN AMENDMENT AND REZONING FOR 1540 ST GEORGES AVENUE AND 215-235 EAST 16TH STREET

The Planner 2 and applicants presented a summary of the Official Community Plan development proposal and land use designation, alignment with mobility strategy goals, site access, bicycle parking, and design of the pedestrian mews. Discussion ensued on construction duration, on-street parking, cycling infrastructure, public realm improvements, traffic congestion mitigation, emergency responder and bicycle parking, local schools' proximity, and population increases.

Kevin Connery arrived at 7:00pm.

It was moved and seconded:

THAT The Integrated Transportation Committee has reviewed the Official Community Plan Amendment and Rezoning for 1540 St Georges Avenue and 215-235 East 16th Street and supports the project, making the following additional comments:

- During construction, ensure pedestrian travel is maintained; including 'good neighbor' agreements to work with other nearby construction sites
- Review traffic flow in laneway, ensuring turning movements from parkade in the lane are safe, possible, and do not impact the neighbourhood
- Review adjacent traffic controls in the neighbourhood to ensure they accommodate increased number of vehicle trips and improve the pedestrian and cyclist experience
- Advocate to the City to consider traffic calming measures on 16th Street, which may include bike-only through-ways, and local area bike safety improvements on key corridors as a result of increased trips being diverted from St Georges.

5. MOBILITY NETWORK IMPLEMENTATION: FUTURE PHASES

Staff presented on the Priority Mobility Network background, the City's past accomplishments in this work, upcoming Priority Network Projects and future considerations for implementing the mobility network to be received for information and consider possibilities for the future.

Discussion ensued on the effectiveness of traffic guidance measures and techniques to ensure the safety of active transportation users.

6. REQUIRED PARKING DIMENSIONS

Staff provided an overview of parking dimensions in the City of North Vancouver and nearby municipalities, trends in vehicle sizes and rationale for parking spot sizes. Members shared feedback on current parking dimensions and mobility challenges.

7. COUNCILLOR UPDATE

Councillor Jessica McIlroy provided an update on recent Council Meeting topics, resolutions going to the Lower Mainland Local Government Association, TransLink funding, and ongoing transportation related projects in the City.

8. TRANSPORTATION EVENTS

Members discussed upcoming transportation related events on the north shore, including “Go by Bike Week”, the Motorcycle Skills Challenge, and North Shore Bike Festival.

9. ROUNDTABLE

Discussion ensued regarding street frontages and continuous awning coverages in the City.

The next regular meeting is scheduled for July 2, 2025.
