- a) I am a Canadian citizen;
- b) I am 18 years of age or older today, **OR** if an election or assent voting is in progress, I will be 18 years of age or older on general voting day for the election or assent voting;
- c) I have been a resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before today;
- d) I have been a registered owner of real property in the City of North Vancouver for at least 30 days immediately before today;
- e) The only persons who are registered owners of the real property identified in (2) above are individuals who are not holding the property in trust for a corporation or any other trust;
- f) I am not entitled to register as a resident elector in the City of North Vancouver;
- g) I have not registered as a non-resident property elector in relation to any other parcel of real property in the City of North Vancouver; and
- h) I am not disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in an election or assent voting and am not otherwise disqualified by law.

Read these Instructions Carefully to Complete the Registration Form

1. Print applicant's surname and given names in full.
2. Print the street address or legal description of the applicant's real property in relation to which the applicant is registering. Applicant *must* attach satisfactory proof that they are entitled to register in relation to the real property referred to in part (2) of the application form (e.g., certificate of title, property tax notice, property assessment notice).
3. Print the applicant's mailing address including street number and name, city/town and postal code.
4. Print *either* the last 6 digits of the applicant's social insurance number *or* the applicant's birthdate. This information is required pursuant to the *Local Government Act*.
5. Complete this section if the applicant's name has changed since previously registering as a non-resident property elector.
6. Applicant must declare that they meet all the requirements listed in this section to register as a non-resident property elector.
7. Applicant must sign the application form in the presence of a witness.
8. The witness to the applicant's signature must sign the application form and print their residential address. Note: The address is not required if the witness is an Election Official.
9. Consent required if there is more than one registered owner: If the land title shows more than one person as a registered owner of the property, you must attach a completed Non-Resident Property Elector Consent Form (Form No. 7-3). To register as a non-resident property elector, you need the written consent of enough of the other registered owners that you and those consenting owners together make up a majority of all registered owners.
10. If registering at the time of voting, 2 pieces of identification (at least one with a signature) to prove identity are required.
11. If registering in advance, please make an appointment with the Election Office (elections@cnv.org | 604-220-1361) and bring this completed form, along with two pieces of identification (one showing your name and current address, and one showing your name and signature), to your appointment. If applicable, also bring the signed Multiple Property Owner Consent Form.
