CONDITIONS

The Fire Chief may issue a permit (a completed application form approved by the Fire Chief) under the following conditions and any additional conditions noted on completed permit:

- 1. Permit will not be transferable and any change in use or operation requires a new permit.
- 2. Permit shall be posted on site in a conspicuous place to the satisfaction of the Fire Chief.
- 3. Portable fire extinguishers are required to be on site at all times.
- 4. If a fire hydrant is required for use during the special effect it shall be opened and closed by personnel acceptable to the City of North Vancouver Engineering Department. The cost for fire hydrant inspection and use shall be determined by the City of North Vancouver Engineering Department.
- 5. All water run off from the filming site shall be contained to the site and if contaminated it shall be disposed of in an acceptable manner determined by the City.
- 6. Any soil contaminated by the use of combustible or flammable liquids or the use of other products, solid, liquid or gas, shall be removed and replaced with clean fill to an acceptable degree. The contaminated soil shall be disposed of by an acceptable method determined by the City.
- 7. All fees for Special Effects will be in accordance with the City of North Vancouver Filming Fee Schedule and deposited in advance with the City.

The North Vancouver City Fire Department will determine the fire suppression and/or fire prevention personnel required.

INDEMNITY: The applicant will, upon approval is granted for the services or facilities requested in the application, indemnify and save harmless the City of North Vancouver from and against any and all claims, including all claims for bodily injury or property damage caused by, arising from or connected with any act or omission of the applicant or any agent, employee, customer, licensee or invitee of the applicant arising out of the filming activity applied for, and against and respect of any such claims or any actions or proceedings brought thereon arising directly or indirectly from or in connection with the property, facilities or services provided by the City of North Vancouver in connection with the filming activity applied for.

INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS: Upon approval of this application, the applicant will submit to the City of North Vancouver an insurance certificate as evidence that comprehensive general liability insurance against claims for personal injury, death or property damage occurring upon or in or about the approved locations in an amount not less than \$5,000,000 per accident or occurrence is in force. The Corporation of the City of North Vancouver and/or their officers, agents, employees and volunteers are to be shown as additional insured but solely with respect to the liability which arises out of the activities of the Named insured. The Municipality reserves the right to set the amount for limit of liability as appropriate.

The City of North Vancouver is to receive 30 days written notice of cancellation or material change.
