
PROJECT UPDATE June 2025

The Harry Jerome Community Recreation Centre and Silver Harbour Seniors' Activity Centre (HJCRC/SH) is set for completion in 2026. The project is currently focused on steel and mass timber structure, building envelope, masonry, interior finishing and mechanical and electrical works.


There is a lot going on inside the new HJCRC – Now that roofing, walls and many windows are in place, the team has made lots of progress on key components within the building. The arena floor is curing, the pools are being water tested, and lighting is being installed. Get a sneak peak by watching this construction video with the project's General Contractor.

Already visible from the street is the ceiling of the Atrium – constructed of mass timber beams, the ceiling soars over the entry to the new HJCRC. The atrium will be your new community living room, where you can come and watch all the activity taking place.
