



# USING THE PASSPORT PARKING APP TO PAY FOR PARKING

### SETTING UP AND USING THE PASSPORT PARKING APP FOR THE FIRST TIME

1 Download the free Passport Parking app from the Apple Store or Google Play Store. You can also find a secure link on our Pay Parking webpage <a href="mailto:cnv.org/payparking">cnv.org/payparking</a>. Alternatively, you can go to <a href="mailto:www.passportparking.com">www.passportparking.com</a> to download the correct app.





**Note:** Be sure to download the navy, white and yellow Passport Parking app as shown above, and do not search for this app in browsers such as Google, Safari, etc. – download this app only from one of the locations mentioned above.

- 2 Once downloaded, change country to Canada and enter your phone number to prompt a verification code to be sent by text. Enter that code.
- 3 Create a PIN. Remember your PIN you will need this if you are signed out of the app and need to sign back in.
- 4 Look for street signs near where you parked. Signs will display a pay parking Zone Code. The code is a 5-digit number starting with 7, and you will need to enter this in the app.

(**Note:** Even if you are only parking for 30 minutes of free time, you must still start a parking session in the app as soon as you park your vehicle.)

- 5 Enter vehicle licence plate number.
- 6 Select amount of parking time.
- 7 Enter payment information.

(**Note:** It is necessary to enter payment details to use the app, even if you are planning to only park for 30 minutes of free time.)

8 Confirm parking zone and licence plate are correct and confirm payment.

(**Note:** If you are booking the free 30-minute parking session, the payment amount will show as \$0.)

#### ADDING A PAYMENT METHOD

- 1 Select Menu in the top-right corner of the screen.
- 2 Select Payment.
- 3 Click the Plus (+) symbol in the top-right corner of the screen to add a new payment method.

**Note:** You can pay with Visa, Mastercard, and American Express.

4 Enter payment details and select Save Card.

**Note:** Once you have started using the app, you can change your payment method at any time by following the above steps.

### **ADDING VEHICLE DETAILS**

To make paying for parking quick and easy, save your vehicle's licence plate details in the Passport Parking app.

- 1 Select Menu in the top-right corner of the screen.
- 2 Select Vehicles.
- 3 Click the Plus (+) symbol in the top-right corner of the screen to add new vehicle details.
- 4 Enter licence plate details and select Save Vehicle.

### **PARKING ZONE CODES**

Use the zone code displayed on parking signage near where you have parked. Zone codes are a 5-digit number and are displayed in red, located in the centre of the pay parking signage (e.g. 70517). You can use the app to pay for parking between 9 a.m. and 9 p.m.





# USING A PAY STATION TO PAY FOR PARKING

### **USING THE PAY STATION**

- 2 Enter licence plate number and press ♥ Start/ Confirm button.
- 3 Select either "30 minutes or less" or "More than 30 minutes" (reminder that the first 30 minutes are free). Use the blue Plus (+) and Minus (-) buttons to adjust the time. When you're ready and your chosen parking time is displayed, press the green Start/Confirm button.
- (Note: Visa, Mastercard and Debit, including Visa Debit, are accepted at pay stations.)

### **TIME OF DAY USE**

Pay stations can be accessed as early as 7 a.m. Pay parking is in effect from 9 a.m. to 9 p.m. If you park in a pay parking space before 9 a.m., you can prepay for your parking session, which will formally begin from 9 a.m.

### **LOCATING PAY STATIONS**

There are typically 1-2 pay stations on each block where there is pay parking. Look for a blue 'Pay Here' sign. On 100 and 200 blocks, pay stations are typically located closer to Lonsdale Ave. A map of all pay stations is available at cnv.org/payparking.
