COURSE REGULATIONS

- Course Hours are from 9:00am Dusk.
- No smoking or drinking alcohol in the park.
- Call RCMP non-emergency line **604.985.1311** to report regulation infractions.

PLAYER COURTESY

- Always give other park users the right of way.
- Help new players learn the rules.
- Do not alter the course in any way (trees, shrubs, baskets, etc.).
- Pick up trash and put in proper receptacles provided.
- Stand behind the player who is throwing until their throw is complete.
- Remain quiet and avoid unnecessary movements while others are throwing.

OBJECTIVE & RULES

The objective is to play each hole in the fewest strokes possible, and the player with the lowest total strokes for the entire course wins the game. One point (stroke) is counted for each disc throw or penalty incurred. A disc coming to rest completely out of bounds (as per map) incurs a one stroke penalty. Players play their next shot from where the disc last crossed out of bounds.

SAFETY FIRST!

Always give other park users the right of way. Never throw when other players or park users are within range. Be aware of your surroundings and environment, and watch for flying discs!
