Boulevard Sidewalk Design

Boulevard sidewalk design enhances pedestrian safety and comfort by creating a buffer between the sidewalk and traffic.

THIS DESIGN OFFERS SEVERAL KEY BENEFITS:

- Increased Safety and Comfort: Greater separation from traffic and parked cars improves the pedestrian experience.
- Improved Accessibility: Designed to provide enough space for two people to walk or roll side by side, while keeping sidewalks clear by placing utility poles, lights, signs, and other utilities in the buffer zone.

• Healthier Urban Tree Canopy: Provides more space and soil volume for trees to grow and thrive. • Better Stormwater Management: Improved design makes better use of permeable surfaces that absorb rainwater runoff, reducing strain on drainage systems.
