


Sidewalk Field: Light, broom finish concrete Banding: Exposed aggregate


Scorelines: Fine trowel joints, flush with surface (to simulate saw cut concrete)










Planters Set back to allowfor entry/exit from cars

Street Trees in raised planters with Silva Cells below











