

ENERGY PERFORMANCE INCENTIVE REQUIREMENTS

(EnerGuide, ASHRAE, NECB)

Revised December 3, 2013

Since January 1, 2011, the City has begun to incent higher energy performance for all new buildings as part of the Energy Efficient Buildings Initiative. Depending on your project and the date on which you apply for permit application, there may be different requirements for those who seek to benefit from the incentives. Please check the following table for the applicable incentive and requirement for your project:

In addition to meeting the required Energy Standard, you will also have to submit specific documentations to verify the project's energy performance, as well as a Letter of Credit for 1% of the construction cost prior to the issuance of a Building Permit, which would be returned once energy performance have been verified.
