Greater Vancouver Sewerage and Drainage District
Application for an Exemption from Part 3 of the Utilities Commission Act

On June 14, 2017, Greater Vancouver Sewerage and Drainage District (GVS&DD) filed an application with the British Columbia Utilities Commission (Commission) for an exemption pursuant to section 88(3) of the *Utilities Commission Act* with respect of GVS&DD's planned project to recover the thermal properties of sewage and provide the heat energy to the Lonsdale Energy Corporation (LEC) municipal district energy system (Application).

The requested exemption would exempt the entity from complying with Part 3 of the *Utilities Commission Act* with respect to the supply and sale of heat energy to LEC.

The Commission would like to seek comments from the public on the Application for the requested exemption.
